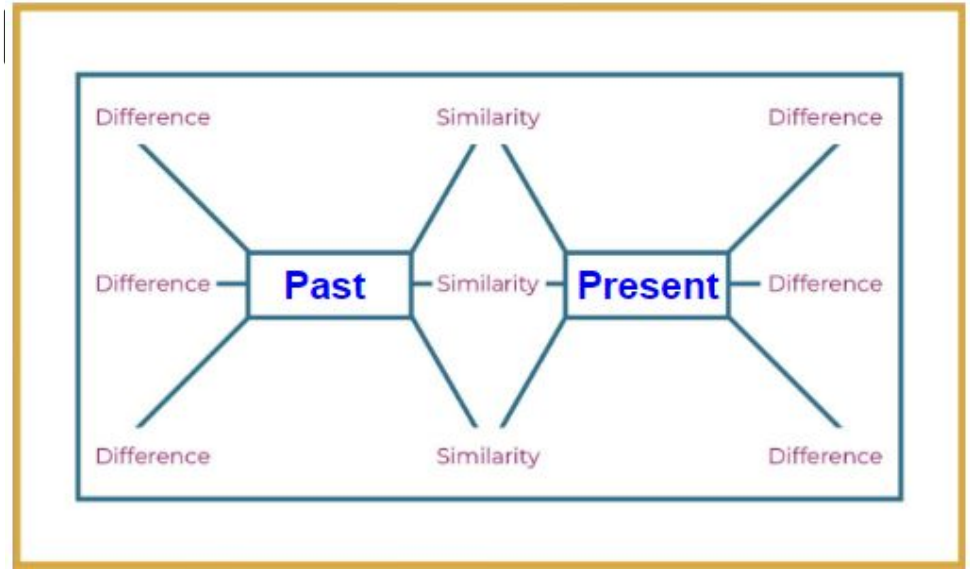


Toys in the present

Compare	Think about things that are similar/alike
Contrast	Think about things that are different
Interviews	A question and answer opportunity to find out information.
Object	An item that can be held and touched.
Painting/picture	An image that has been drawn/painted that shows/tells us something.
Past	Something that happened before now/the current time - e.g. yesterday, earlier today, last week, last year.
Photograph	An image that was taken at the time to create a memory or reminder of something.
Present	Something that is happening now in current time.
